

Show Tips & Policies

1) All dance families must have all competition fees and tuition paid up-to-date in order to compete.

STAGE

2) Everything you say and do at the show reflects on our studio, be sweet. :)

3) Must be QUIET backstage at all times, No parents allowed please! Instructors only.

4) Absolutely no Talking to Judges at Anytime! Please be respectful to all staff & fellow competitors.

COSTUMES & MAKE-UP

5) Make sure you have the right shoes and accessories for your dances. (See Competition Supply List)

6) All dancer make-up should be the same. Please make sure you have purchased the correct color palette. (See Company Make-Up, on WDA website)

7) Need help with how to apply make-up? Go Online to: JAMCOSMETICS.NET

8) Please label your costumes with dancers name and keep them in a garment bag!

9) Absolutely no undergarments under your costumes. Tights only.

10) There is usually an area on-site to be used as a Dressing Room before rehearsal. (Room 4- labeled on On-Site Map)

REHEARSALS

11) Full costume *including* make-up and hair needs to be finished with extra pins, before attending on-site rehearsals (Approx. 2 hours before your performance).

12) Please arrive at the scheduled on-site rehearsals ON TIME. We have a short opportunity to practice together before Showtime...Let's make it count! (See On-Site Rehearsal Schedule, on WDA Website)

AWARDS

13) All dancers are invited on stage during awards ceremonies, shortly following there performance.

14) Please stay after your performance to attend your awards ceremony and please sit together.

15) Performers must be in full costume, or if you have a long wait after your performance you may wear your company warm-ups.

16) DANCERS: Listen for your routine name and/or studio name to be called and be prompt about standing up to accept your award. This is what you are here for, not to chit chat. :)

17) Please be supportive during awards and show ALL performers congratulations. Smiles and Applause are always appreciated.

EXTRAS

18) No other activities the day of your performance. Please stay well rested and hydrated. Eat and use the restroom at least one hour before Showtime.

19) If you are present, We ask that you please attend all WDA studio performances to show your support for your fellow dancers! (See Master Routine Schedule on WDA website for list of performance times)

20) Spectators, Family, and Friends get in FREE to the convention hall the entire weekend.

21) A phone list will be provided with all performers' phone numbers so that students can contact each other for extra practice over the competition weekend.

22) MOST of ALL have FUN, FUN, FUN! Please be Helpful & Positive in every way.
